the fourth international workshop on new worlds in astroparticle physics was the latest in the biennial series held in faro portugal the program included both invited and contributed talks each of the sessions opened with a pedagogical overview of the current state of the respective field the following topics were covered cosmological parameters neutrino physics and astrophysics gravitational waves beyond standard models strings cosmic rays origin propagation and interaction matter under extreme conditions supernovae and dark matter the proceedings have been selected for coverage in index to scientific technical proceedings istp cdrom version isi proceedings

although many americans consider the establishment of the colonies as the birth of this country in fact early america already existed long before the arrival of the europeans from coast to coast native americans had created enduring cultures and the subsequent european invasion remade much of the existing land and culture in new worlds for all colin calloway explores the unique and vibrant new cultures that indians and europeans forged together in early america the journey toward this hybrid society kept europeans and indians lives tightly entwined living working worshiping traveling and trading together as well as fearing avoiding despising and killing one another in the west settlers lived in indian towns eating indian food in mohawk valley new york europeans tattooed their faces indians drank tea and a unique american identity emerged

this book is about charles fort his followers and the surprising influence they have had on science fiction the avant garde ufology and more broadly on the role of spirituality and conspiracy in the modern world fort was an author and maverick philosopher who wrote four non fiction books about anomalies rains of frogs mysterious disappearances unexplained lights in the sky for which he offered hypotheses that even he did not always accept as true his books developed into a monistic

philosophy that denounced science as a machine for generating truth in his view science was a small part of a larger system in which truth and falsity were constantly transforming one into the other this was not a rejection of the modern world but instead its fulfillment fort prophesied the next stage in intellectual evolution after the scientific era he inspired four overlapping groups members of the fortean society science fiction fans and writers avant garde artists and flying saucer enthusiasts first we must think to new worlds takes up each of these groups in turn to ask how can the human imagination be expanded what is the fundamental structure of the universe and how does power move as they developed their responses fort s followers mixed forteanism with fundamentalism new agery and conspiracy as well as a host of other forms of modern enchantments such as the ironic imagination scientific wonder and theosophical syncretism each chapter is interrupted by and concludes with shorter sections that focus on particular forteans or fortean events as a way to deepen themes

primary exports are unlikely to be material goods but intellectual products created by a technically adept population in a frontier environment where people will be forced to innovate including gmos robotics ai and power production zubrin even predicts the red planet s customs social relations and government of the people by the people for the people with inalienable individual rights that will overcome traditional forms of oppression to draw talented earth immigrants in 1776 thomas paine wrote we have it in our power to begin the world over again zubrin inspires us to embrace another magnificent future today with the right pieces in place his red planet will become a pressure cooker for invention benefiting humans on earth mars and beyond the new world on mars proves that there is no point killing each other over provinces on earth when together we can create planets

the making of new world slavery argues that independent commerce geared to burgeoning consumer markets was the driving force behind the rise of plantation slavery the baroque state sought successfully to feed upon this commerce and with markedly less success to regulate slavery and racial relations to illustrate this thesis blackburn examines the deployment of slaves in the colonial possessions of the portuguese the spanish the dutch the english and the french plantation slavery is shown to have emerged from the impulses of civil society not from the strategies of individual states robin blackburn argues that the organization of slave plantations placed the west on a destructive path to modernity and that greatly preferable alternatives were both proposed and rejected finally he shows that the surge of atlantic trade predicated on the murderous toil of the plantations made a decisive contribution to both the industrial revolution and the rise of the west

this collection of essays examines the polyvalent concept of new worlds in the context of medieval and early modern sermon studies while the terms old world and new world are commonplace in studies of europe and the americas this volume explores how preaching in the atlantic world and beyond creatively engaged audiences in addressing new cultural and religious perspectives regardless of their geographical location and time period the identification of the other in sermons is already an implicit recognition of a novel world which could be equally enticing and intimidating the scholars represented in this volume examine a wide panorama of medieval and early modern efforts as they identify how sermons which often served as a highly effective media of mass communication reflect shifting identities sometimes contested and sometimes embraced

within long standing traditional constructs particular themes include apocalypticism art and mission cultural interaction multilingualism forms of religious life and theological innovation

managing trade relations in the new world economy analyses the implications of the new world economy for global trade thomas andersson explores how manufactured exports have increased exponentially while the western economies have accrued massive current account deficits warning against the dangers of protectionism he argues that the future of the world trading system may depend upon the external policies of the ec

america in 1908 near folsom new mexico a cowboy discovered the remains of a herd of extinct giant bison by examining flint points embedded in the bones archeologists later determined that a band of humans had killed and butchered the animals 12 450 years ago this discovery vastly expanded america s known human history but also revealed the long standing danger homo sapiens presented to the continent s evolutionary richness distinguished author dan flores s ambitious history chronicles the epoch in which humans and animals have coexisted in the wild new world of north america a place shaped both by its own grand evolutionary forces and by momentous arrivals from asia africa and europe with portraits of iconic creatures such as mammoths horses wolves and bison flores describes the evolution and historical ecology of north america like never before the arrival of humans precipitated an extraordinary disruption of this teeming environment flores treats humans not as a species apart but as a new animal entering two continents that had never seen our likes before he shows how our long past as carnivorous hunters helped us settle america initially establishing a coast to coast culture that lasted longer than the present united states but humanity s success had devastating consequences for other creatures in telling this epic story flores traces the origins of today s sixth extinction to the spread of humans around the world tracks the story of a hundred centuries of native america explains how old world ideologies precipitated 400 years of market driven slaughter that devastated so many ancient american species and explores the decline and miraculous recovery of species in recent decades in thrilling narrative style informed by genomic science evolutionary biology and environmental history flores celebrates the astonishing bestiary that arose on our continent and introduces the complex human cultures and individuals who hastened its eradication studied america s animals and moved heaven and earth to rescue them eons in scope and continental in scale wild new world is a sweeping yet intimate big history of the animal human story in america

the nazis use and misuse of nietzsche is well known the superman the will to power nietzsche s equation of bourgeois

democracy and decadence and his denigration of reason were staples of nazi propaganda communists also used and misused nietzsche but that fact is largely unknown because soviet propagandists invoked reason and labeled nietzsche the philosopher of fascism even while covertly appropriating his ideas in this pioneering book bernice glatzer rosenthal excavates the trail of long obscured nietzschean ideas that took root in late imperial russia intertwining with other elements in the culture to become a vital ingredient of bolshevism and stalinism nietzsche made a difference he furnished intellectual ammunition for a prolonged conflict about culture society and politics that began around the turn of the century his first russian admirers were poets philosophers and political activists they responded to the changes transforming their society by espousing new values and seeking a new faith by which to live and work this response resulted in new aesthetic and political amalgams such as symbolism futurism nietzschean christianity and nietzschean marxism the ensuing debates between and among their partisans reverberated throughout the wider culture and therefore also into bolshevism becoming the subject of an uninterrupted polemic between bolsheviks and non bolsheviks and among bolsheviks that continued into the 1930s in stalin s time unacknowledged nietzschean ideas were used to mobilize the masses for the great tasks of the first five year plan and the cultural revolution which was intended to eradicate bourgeois values and attitudes from soviet life and to construct a distinctly socialist culture nietzsche s belief that people need illusions to shield them from reality underlay socialist realism the official soviet aesthetic from 1934 on in the aftermath of de stalinization the government cast nietzsche as the personification of bourgeois nihilism and bourgeois individualism soviet intellectuals wishing to reappropriate their lost cultural heritage discovered the nietzsche influenced intellectuals of late imperial russia and reopened discussion on the issues they had posed more than an exercise in historical rediscovery new myth new world offers a new interpretation of modern russian history by uncovering the buried influence of nietzschean ideas on soviet culture and politics rosenthal opens new avenues for understanding soviet ideology and its influence on the twentieth century

a contemporary evaluation of bergelson and his works examining yiddish literature jewish culture and modernism david bergelson 1884 1952 emerged as a major literary figure who wrote in yiddish before ww1 he was one of the founders of the kiev kultur lige and his work was at the center of the yiddish speaking world of the time he was well known for creating characters who often felt the painful after effects of the past and the clumsiness of bodies stumbling through the actions of daily life as their familiar worlds crumbled around them in this contemporary assessment of bergelson and his fiction harriet murav focuses on untimeliness anachronism and warped temporality as an emotional sensory existential and historical background to bergelson s work and world murav grapples with the great modern theorists of time and memory especially henri bergson sigmund freud and walter benjamin to present bergelson as an integral part of the philosophical and artistic experiments political and technological changes and cultural context of russian and yiddish modernism that marked his age as a comparative and interdisciplinary study of yiddish literature and jewish culture this work adds a new ethnic dimension to understandings of the turbulent birth of modernism harriet murav treats bergelson with the care and sincerity that literary critics have shown other important writers this is a masterpiece of literary scholarship that will be sure to transform not only how people read bergelson and who chooses to read bergelson but how readers engage with the entire concept of modernism itself david shneer author of yiddish and the creation of soviet jewish culture 1918 1930

use of the principle of selection to explain social development the articles in on the psychology of society 1904 06 discredit the neo kantian philosophy of russia s marxist revisionists rebut their critique of historical materialism and develop the idea that labour technology determines social consciousness new world 1905 envisions how humankind will develop under socialism and bogdanov s contributions to studies in the realist worldview 1904 05 defend the labour theory of value and criticise neo kantian sociology

this book is a broad synthesis of new world monkey evolution integrating their unique evolutionary story into the bigger picture of primate evolution and amazon biodiversity capsule for more than 30 million years new world monkeys have inhabited the forests of south and central america whether these primates originally came from africa by rafting across the atlantic or crossing overland from north america they soon flourished this book tells the story of these new world monkeys integrating data from fossil and living animals it explores the evolution of the three major new world monkey lineages as well as how they fit into the broader story of primate evolution and amazon biodiversity after providing readers with necessary background in primate taxonomy and systematics rosenberger shows that the notion of adaptive zones is central to our understanding of primate evolution the idea of adaptive zones can explain how radiations evolve morphological adaptations appear and communities form from here rosenberger synthesizes what is known about new world monkeys unique ecological adaptations including those involving feeding and locomotion as well as their social behaviour the book s concluding chapters explore theories of how primates first arrived in south america and what their future looks like given the threat of extinction biography internal use only alfred l rosenberger is professor emeritus of biological anthropology at brooklyn college an expert on the origin and evolution of new world monkeys rosenberger has contributed numerous articles in edited volumes and his work is published in journals such as nature journal of human evolution and american journal of primatology audience the audience for this book is scholars and graduate students in biological physical anthropolog and primatology and to a lesser extent conservation biology evolutionary biology and behavioral ecology rationale no copy text other relevant info no copy text

society education as indoctrination issues of class and resistance colonialism imperialism and much more the thread through it all is that every topic and the list above takes us just about halfway through this book reveals how social systems work what their impact on humanity is and how they are treated by the elite mainstream intellectuals and leftists it gets personal theoretical and observational the lessons are relevant to all times so far and pretty much all places and chomsky's logical scalpel with moral guidance is relentless

two issues are bothering the humanity at present firstly the contemporary national and international scenarios in socioeconomic political ethnic and cultural domains are throwing up many issues problems and challenges relating to development environment human rights human security communal harmony peaceful coexistence among nations and world peace and security secondly existing global institutions are proving to be wanting in their structures and authorities in solving these problems alternatively a new global independent organization with enforcing authority is needed to act upon and solve these issues the need for replacement of UNO seems to be justified because of failure to solve global problems the nineteenth and twentieth centuries witnessed revivals of proposals for world government that were fueled by positive developments such as technological progress in travel and communications that enabled rapid economic globalization as well as negative developments such as the devastating impact of wars fought with modern technology the author's approach of the formation of the world parliament is through proportional representation of nation's parliaments thus avoids direct election process for its formation all the nations and their people's representatives are involved in the formation of the world parliament and the world government based on this line of thinking the structure for a new federal world government and the new federal world constitution are presented in this book

in this beautifully conceived book ayesha ramachandran reconstructs the imaginative struggles of early modern artists

philosophers and writers to make sense of something that we take for granted the world imagined as a whole once a new exciting and frightening concept the world was transformed in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries but how could one envision something that no one had ever seen in its totality the worldmakers moves beyond histories of globalization to explore how the world itself variously understood as an object of inquiry a comprehensive category and a system of order was self consciously shaped by human agents gathering an international cast of characters from dutch cartographers and french philosophers to portuguese and english poets ramachandran describes a history of firsts the first world atlas the first global epic the first modern attempt to develop a systematic natural philosophy all part of an effort by early modern thinkers to capture the world on the page
